HISTORY

The name Mountain Plains was first written in a deed drafted in 1773 by Thomas Jefferson to transfer the ownership of a land grant farm established in 1737. Roseland Farm, the home of King Family Vineyards, now sits on part of that original land grant. We hope to honor this heritage with an expression of our terroir and of our history by bottling this small snapshot in the centuries long story of the place that we call home.

WINEMAKING

Aged in 400 liter acacia barrels for 10 months, this dry rosé is made from 90% Petit Verdot and 10% Merlot. Strawberry, spice, and subtle savory aromas lead to a lively and bright finish. This medium-bodied rose is perfect for an afternoon on the farm, or to start (and finish) an evening at home!
